## GROUNDS OF APPEAL

Under paragraph 8 of Schedule 1 of the Environmental Regulation (Enforcement Measures) (Scotland) Order 2015, an appeal may be made on one or more of the following grounds:

- (a) the decision was based on an error of fact;
- (b) the decision was wrong in law;
- (c) the decision was unreasonable;
- (d) any other reason.

Note: It is not a valid ground of appeal that SEPA failed to comply with guidance issued to it by the Lord Advocate.
